Thank you for attending the meeting regarding the above situation and understand the difficulties faced by the CEO's. However, unfortunately, where the Mayor lives is located within a single yellow line boundary, bus stop and traffic lights. I have looked into parking the Mayor's car somewhere else, but will still have to leave the car unattended for a short time, while offload the Mayoral chains with or without Robes. The problem we have is that there is no other side streets to park in as

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including part of is closed off for emergency vehicle access only. This will mean that will has to drive over into RBKC along turning right into our borough roads, then as you know - parking is very difficult! Then 20mins round walk to and from the Mayor house (instead of 8mins) once chained or Robe to collect the car and do a reverse trip to collect the Mayor, which will be none productive.

have taking on board your valid comments, which do agree and drivers will no longer park onto the dropped curb, which may form part of the public highway from now on, would ask that your CEO's and the contracted tow away company are aware that the Mayor lives at that address and will not have the Mayoral Crest on the BMW until the Mayor is in the car.

The current mayor's term ends on the last Wednesday in May, which I hope may give some relief towards these issues.
