I am very disappointed to learn today that the vital work associated with this WPR dated 16 June 2011 has still not been carried out after more than 2 months!

This will cause the Council to lose a significant amount of revenue as we have to review every potential CCTV contravention within a statutory timescale. Without the additional reviewing capacity requested through this WPR, we will not be able to review all of our cases in time and will therefore lose the resultant revenue.

Basically, this need to be resolved by this Friday 2nd September 2011.

If the work is not completed by then I will need a written explanation from HFBP for Nigel Pallace explaining why the additional review station capacity has not been provided despite the passage of 2 1/2 months.
